Dear Friends.

We pray you and your family are doing well. We want to let you know about our re-opening services at IMBC. Beginning **Sunday, May 31**, we will resume morning services in a slightly altered schedule. **We will have 2 Sunday morning services.** At this time, we **will not** have Sunday School. We **will not** have a choir, Sunday evening or Wednesday evening services.

The first Sunday service will be at 10:00 AM in the Fellowship hall. This service will be primarily for our seniors 60 and up, as well as any at "risk" members. Seats will be arranged to maintain "social distancing". Please park in the Fellowship hall parking area for this service.

The second service will be held in the Sanctuary at 11:00 AM for the remainder of our folks. To minimize exposure and for the safety of everyone, nursery will not be provided and there will not be Children's Church or youth meetings. Children are welcome to remain with their parents during this time of worship. Please practice "social distancing" in the sanctuary. We ask that immediate family, living under the same roof, be seated together. Please park in the B Street parking area for this service.

You will receive a One Call survey asking if you plan to attend one of these services. You will be asked to respond with **1 for yes, I will attend**; or respond with **2 for no, I will not attend**. This will help us better plan the seating arrangement.

A few guidelines:

- You are welcome to attend either service. The above is just a suggestion.
- The 11:00 AM service will be available on YouTube after the service is completed.
- We will not have our time of meet and greet.
- A box will be available at each entrance for tithes and offerings.
- Hand sanitizer and face masks will be available at each service.

These guidelines are for your safety. "This too shall pass" and we will get back to our normal schedule!
